Playing & Exploring Engagement	<b>Finding out and exploring</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Show curiosity about objects, events and people</li> <li>❖ Use senses to explore the world around them</li> <li>❖ Engage in open-ended activity</li> <li>❖ Show particular interests</li> </ul>
	<b>Playing with what they know</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Pretend objects are things from their experience</li> <li>❖ Represent their experiences in play</li> <li>❖ Take on a role in their play</li> <li>❖ Act out experiences with other people</li> </ul>
	<b>Being willing to have a go</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Initiate activities</li> <li>❖ Seek challenge</li> <li>❖ Show a 'can do' attitude</li> <li>❖ Take a risk, engage in new experiences, and learn by trial and error</li> </ul>
Active Learning Motivation	<b>Being involved and concentrating</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Maintain focus on their activity for a period of time</li> <li>❖ Show high levels of energy, fascination</li> <li>❖ Not easily distracted</li> <li>❖ Pay attention to details</li> </ul>
	<b>Keeping on trying</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Persist with activity when challenges occur</li> <li>❖ Show belief that more effort or different approach will pay off</li> <li>❖ Bounce back after difficulties</li> </ul>
	<b>Enjoying achieving what they set out to do</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Show satisfaction in meeting their own goals</li> <li>❖ Be proud of how they accomplished something - not just the end result</li> <li>❖ Enjoy meeting challenges for their own sake rather than external rewards or praise</li> </ul>
Creating & Thinking Critically Thinking	<b>Having their own ideas</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Think of ideas</li> <li>❖ Find ways to solve problems</li> <li>❖ Find new ways to do things</li> </ul>
	<b>Making links</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Make links and noticing patterns in their experience</li> <li>❖ Make predictions</li> <li>❖ Test their ideas</li> <li>❖ Develop ideas of grouping, sequences, cause and effect</li> </ul>
	<b>Choosing ways to do things</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Plan, making decisions about how to approach a task, solve a problem and reach a goal</li> <li>❖ Check how well their activities are going</li> <li>❖ Change strategy as needed</li> <li>❖ Review how well the approach worked</li> </ul>
