## I like being a Mathematician:

- Recap the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.
- Use some kitchen scales and measure ingredients out when cooking or baking.
- Chose a multiple of 10 and see if you can identify the previous multiple of 10 and the next multiple of 10.

## I like being a reader, a writer and being creative with words:

- Read labels on food packages, tins, toys, games.
- Write a letter to Mrs Graves about the importance of recycling.
- Make a leaflet about conservation areas in and near Ramsgate and read the map to find their locations.

## I like being creative:

- Draw a map of Ramsgate using symbols to represent important features: Peel tower, Holcombe hill, urn, park and church.
- Design and create a 3D sculpture of a building – you could use Paper Mache or paper straws, cocktail sticks and marshmallows.

## I like being a Scientist:

- How many small objects can you find in your home that may be absorbent, transparent, and opaque?
- Look at chocolate and see how you can make it melt – how does chocolate start and finish once it is heated up?
- Recycle – what can you recycle at home? Could you make something from your recycled item?

## I like being an active learner:

- Visit a sculpture trail like Irwell Sculpture Trail and see what things you discover on your trip.
- Visit your local junior parkrun- to run, walk or volunteer.
