Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome to Year 2! We hope you and your family have had a lovely summer break and that your child is ready for the year ahead. Here is some information which we hope you will find useful.

Year 2 Staff

Mrs Ardill will be in class on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Mrs McLaughlin will teach all day on a Friday. Ms Nicholson will be our Teaching Assistant each day and will sometimes also teach the class. Mrs Hill will teach us music and Mr Ramsbottom will teach PE. Mrs Dawson, Mrs Steers and Mrs Eaton will also be working in our class each day.

Reading Books

Reading books will be changed on a **Monday**. Your child will bring home two books for the week. Please make sure the books are in your child's book bag on a Monday ready to be changed and that their bookmark is with their book. The bookmarks will be used to check that books have been returned. All reading should be logged using the Boom Reader App. You can find your child's login details in their homework books. Please contact school if you require further support accessing this. Reading books will be sent home the week beginning 9th September.

Each year, we challenge the Year 2 children to read as many books as they can from our suggested book list. This can be found on our class page on the school website.

Topic Homework

Your child will be bringing home their homework books in their reading bags later this week. You will find a **Homework Grid** inside for the first half term. This grid can also be found on the

school website. Please encourage your child to complete at least two of the activities before Thursday 17th October. The vocabulary on the grid can be practised at home but this will be separate from the weekly spellings. Work can be sent into school or put on Seesaw. The activities can be as creative as you like 😊

Spellings

Spelling homework will be set on a **Thursday** starting this Thursday 5th September. The spellings will be set as an assignment on Spelling Shed (login can be found in homework book) and a paper copy will be stuck in homework books. Children can then practise their spellings using their preferred method. We will have a Spelling Test every **Wednesday**.

Logins

All of your child's login details will be stuck in the front of their homework book. These include: Seesaw, Boom Reader (Go Read), EdShed (Spelling Shed), Times Tables Rockstars/ Numbots and IDL.

Seesaw

We will be using Seesaw to upload photographs and videos of our learning and also to send notices etc. Please let us know if you require support accessing your child's account.

PE

PE will be on a Thursday each week with Mr Ramsbottom. Children may come to school in their PE kits on this day. The children will have another PE session in the week but they will wear their school uniform for this session.

We hope this information has answered any questions that you had, if not, please do not hesitate to ask.
