Choose a small object and ask a grown up to help, can you throw and catch to each other, past 20? Can you throw up high and catch? Can you throw and catch with both hands?	 Can you talk to an older person that you know (a grandparent, or an eldery neighbour perhaps) Ask them what it was like when they went to school.what was there favourite lessons? What toys did they play with? Did they walk to school or go in the car? Do you have any very old photos at home of special family members that we can share at school? 	FS1- make a shopping list to help mummy/daddy when they go shopping? You could draw the things they need to buy then try and think about the sounds at the start of each word and if you know them have a go at writing the sounds on your list! FS2- can you write a list of facts about your favouite animal? Where does it live? What colour is it? What does it eat? (don't forget to you capital letters, full stops and finger spces!)	FS1- can you draw things that you do in the morning and then things that you do in the evening? Ask your mummy/daddy what time you wake up and what time you go to bed, can you write those special numbers? FS2- with support can you look at the clock 'face' and read all of the numbers? What does 1 o clock look like? What does 5 o clock look like? When it is time for bed, can you find the time on a clock?
