This term, we are going to be learning all about Mexico

I like being a historian:

Research some of the different myths, legends and Gods of the Ancient Maya. You can be as creative as you want in how you present your findings.

Here are some ideas: a comic strip, a 'story shoebox', an informative PowerPoint, a song or rap.

I like baking and cooking:

Find a recipe for a traditional and delicious Mexican food such as enchiladas, tacos or churros. Prepare a meal of your choice with an adult for your family to enjoy!

(You could even try to convince your family to take you to a Mexican restaurant or take away as 'research'!)

I like using different languages:

In, Mexico, the most commonly spoken language is Spanish. Can you find out how to say some phrases in Spanish? Do you know anyone who speaks Spanish? Impress them with your new knowledge!

You could design a poster of common Spanish phrases and illustrate this to help younger learners.

I like to draw and be creative

Find out about Frida Kahlo, one of Mexico's most famous artists. Draw, paint or create a digital image taking inspiration from her style of artwork.

Or you could design and build a Mayan Temple out of junk resources you have at home. You could use cardboard boxes, newspaper, toilet rolls, or you could use lego or playdough.

Key Vocabulary:

Learn the meaning and spellings of: Civilisation, Climate, Culture, Indigenous, Landscape, Altitude, Region

I like being a scientist

In science, we are learning about evolution and inheritance. Find out about the inherited traits in your family. Record your data in a table and then present it in a graph. You could consider traits such as hair/ eye colour, ear lobes, widow's peak and freckles.

I being a mathematician

Find out about different means of transport to Mexico. How long does it take? How far away is it from the UK?

Research temperatures in Mexico during summer and winter and compare them to the UK. Present your findings on a graph.

I being a researcher

Do you know anyone who has been to Mexico? If so, can you talk to the person and find out more about their experiences of the food and culture there? Where did they go or visit? Can you locate this on a map?
