- Continue to practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Research the height of Stone Age monuments. you could look at Stonehenge.

- Create a Stone Age wall painting. It must tell the story of your tribe (handprints, paw prints, food you eat etc.)
- Create or design a Stone Age tool that might have been useful to an early man.
- Create a menu fit for an early human. Think about what they might have hunted or foraged.
