I like being creative:

City Skyline Art – Create a silhouette or collage of the skylines of Manchester and Rio using different materials (paint, collage, digital tools).

Carnival Mask Design – Design and decorate a Rio Carnival mask, researching traditional colours and patterns.

Music Comparison – Listen to songs from both cities (e.g., Samba and Manchester bands like Oasis) and create a poster comparing their styles.

Football Team Logos – Design a football team logo for either city, inspired by Manchester United/City or Brazilian clubs like Flamengo.

I like being a mathematician:

Currency Conversion – Convert prices of everyday items between British Pounds and Brazilian Reais using exchange rates.

Distance Challenge – Calculate the distance between Manchester and Rio and explore how long it would take to travel by different methods (plane, boat, walking).

Data Handling – Compare population sizes, temperatures, or rainfall in a bar chart or line graph.

Football Stats – Compare football statistics from teams in both cities (goals scored, matches won) and answer problem-solving questions.

I like being scientific:

Climate Comparison – Research and compare the climates of Manchester and Rio, recording average temperatures and rainfall.

Ecosystem Study – Research and draw food chains for animals found in the Amazon Rainforest (Rio) and the Peak District (Manchester).

Materials in Architecture – Compare building materials used in Manchester and Rio and explore why they are suitable for each city's climate.

Water Cycle in Both Cities – Explain how the water cycle works and how rainfall affects each city's environment.

I like reading and writing

Postcard from Rio or Manchester – Write a postcard as if visiting one of the cities, describing what they see and do.

Persuasive Travel Brochure – Create a travel brochure encouraging tourists to visit either city.

Diary Entry – Write a diary entry as someone experiencing Carnival in Rio or a match at Old Trafford/Etihad Stadium.

Fact File – Write a fact file comparing the two cities, including key information like landmarks, weather, and famous people.
