Tickets are now on open sale! Hurry tickets are selling fast! - **£4 each** (Entry is strictly by ticket only.)

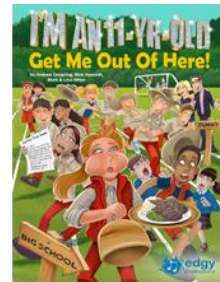
All children in Y3, Y4, Y5 are expected to attend the evening performance to support the Y6 children, as well as the afternoon performance.
